



**Derek K Swemmer** (BA Hons, MA, D Litt et Phil, TTHD) is the Registrar at the University of the Witwatersrand, Johannesburg (Wits). He taught English at Christ's Hospital, a popular public school in England, for one year before spending five years on the academic staff of each of the departments of English at the University of Pretoria and the University of South Africa.
