A graduate of the United States Military Academy in 1981, he served five years active duty in air defense artillery while stationed in West Germany and Fort Ord, California. He is a graduate of the officer's advance course, US Army Ranger School, Airborne School and the officer's basic course. Mr. York also holds a Master's Degree in Human Resources Management from Houston Baptist University.

He joined Compaq Computer Corporation in 1987 soon after leaving the military and was part of the original staffing organization at the company. While there, Compaq grew from \$625 million in sales to over \$25 billion in sales. From 1991 to 1996, Mr. York served as the top staffing executive at Compaq responsible for managing all recruiting initiatives to include all college recruiting and university relations for both graduate and undergraduate recruiting.

In 1996, Mr. York was recruited to join NationsBank as the Senior Vice President of Recruiting supporting a 70,000 person bank. Within two years, the bank had acquired three major banks and became Bank of America with over 200,000 employees. Mr. York was responsible for leading staffing and directly managed all college and university relations programs, diversity recruiting, executive recruiting, advertising, recruiting strategy and research.

In 2001, Mr. York joined one of the major executive search firms as a partner who was recently acquired by Heidrick & Struggles. In 2003, he opened his own executive search firm serving clients in both the US and Europe.

Mr. York has served on a number of boards in addition to serving as the Corporate Chair of the Golden Key Board of Directors from 1998–2000. Previously, Mr. York served on the Academic Curriculum Advisory Board, Houston Baptist University Board, St. Cecilia Catholic School Board, Strake Jesuit College Preparatory Booster Club Board, Black Data Processing Association Board, National Society of Hispanic MBAs, West Point Society of Greater Houston and the US Military Academy Board.
